



Robert Thomson Scholarship
Greater Worcester Community Foundation

This scholarship was created in 2009 by the estate of Robert Thomson. It is awarded to the descendants of former employees of the Christie and Thomson Companies, Inc. of Southbridge, and to graduates of Worcester Technical High School who are pursuing education in the automotive field.

Robert Thomson was President of the Christie and Thomson Companies during the 1950's when the business was a dynamic force in the automotive industry. Mr. Thomson passed away in 1970, and his wife, Rae, died in 1978. They specified in their will that any future real estate proceeds would be held in trust to provide college scholarships for the employees of the Christie and Thomson Companies. In 2000, Christie and Thompson was sold, and in 2006, the remaining entities were dissolved. Those sales funded this scholarship, which honors Robert Thomson and his generous wish to provide educational assistance to his employees and their families.
